

CONFLICT MINERALS CERTIFICATION

The 2010 Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and related rules finalized by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) in 2012, impose certain reporting requirements on manufacturers if their products contain metals derived from minerals defined as "conflict minerals." This reporting requirement is intended to eliminate funding for armed conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries ("covered countries" are the Democratic Republic of Congo, Burundi, Central African Republic, Tanzania, Zambia, Angola, Rwanda, South Sudan, and Uganda). As a publicly traded company, United Rotorcraft ("UR") is required to ensure that our supply chain complies with these requirements. We request completion of this certification to assist us in this regard. After reviewing your responses, we may have additional questions.

Conflict Minerals:

- **Columbite-tantalite** (or coltan, the colloquial African term) is the metal ore from which the element **tantalum** is extracted.
- **Cassiterite** is the chief ore needed to produce **tin**.
- **Wolframite** is an important source of the element **tungsten**.
- **Gold**.
